Achievement is strong across both A Levels and the vocational BTEC qualifications. As examples of this, approaching 20% of all A Level grades were A*/A and almost half of all grades were A*-B. In the vocational courses, 60% of all grades were Distinction*/Distinction and 89% Distinction*-Merit. An impressive 66% of our students achieved at least one of these top grades.
