Dear Parent/Carer,

### Re: Year 11 Target Setting Day – Thursday, 23 November 2023

I write as a reminder that normal lessons will not take place on **Thursday, 23 November because of our annual Target Setting Day (TSD)**. The reason for this is to allow all students to meet with their tutor to **discuss current achievements and to set targets for future improvement**. In some cases, students may have meetings with their Year Leader or a member of the Learning Support team to discuss progress. **Some students may also be invited to targeted sessions to support their progress in maths or science (parents/carers will be informed separately if this applies to your child)**. TSD is an important part of our school year as it enables parents/carers, students, and staff to work together to identify, support and monitor the targets that will make a real difference to each individual's progress over the coming year. This year our follow-up Target Review Day will be on Wednesday, 27 March 2024 where each student's progress against the agreed targets is reviewed and celebrated.

**Your contributions during the TSD meeting are greatly valued.** Meetings last for approximately 10 minutes. During this time the tutor will give out your son/daughter's report and all will discuss current progress and agree the main two targets for improvement. These should relate to academic progress and notes will be written in the student planner in the 'My Learning Goals' section.

**Between now and Wednesday, 22 November your child will agree with their form tutor a time that suits you both. If you cannot attend, please indicate this on the reply slip and we will allocate a time for your child alone.**

Please remember that on the day, including the journey to and from school, your child should be dressed in **full school uniform**. Students who receive free school meals will be able to collect a packed lunch from the canteen after/before their appointment. **Students will attend school only for their individual Target Setting meeting** and should be working at home for the rest of their day.

We also take the opportunity on the day to **check and update the contact details** we hold for each student, and I would ask that you take a few minutes to check and amend these, if required, after your meeting. Furthermore, we can provide help with logging on to Satchel One on this day, if you have not yet done so.

We look forward to seeing you on Thursday, 23 November and working together to make sure your child is successful at school.
